OBJETIVOS DEL CURSO

1. **EXPRESIÓN ORAL: USAR UNA SERIE DE FRASES Y ORACIONES BÁSICAS PARA EXPRESAR NECESIDADES, OPINIONES Y SENTIMIENTOS BÁSICOS RELACIONADOS CON LA REALIDAD COTIDIANA.**
2. **EXPRESIÓN ESCRITA: ESCRIBIR UNA SERIE DE FRASES Y ORACIONES BÁSICAS PARA EXPRESAR OPINIONES SIMPLES Y ASPECTOS BÁSICOS DE SU VIDA DIARIA, USANDO NEXOS ELEMENTALES COMO *AND*, *BUT* Y *BECAUSE*.**
3. **COMPRENSIÓN AUDITIVA: ENTENDER LENGUAJE SIMPLE, CLARO Y ARTICULADO PAUSADAMENTE.**
4. **COMPRENSIÓN DE LECTURA: LEER Y ENTENDER TEXTOS BÁSICOS (CARTAS, NOTAS PERSONALES, ANUNCIOS, ARTÍCULOS BREVES Y SIMPLES, ETC.).**

- Verbs, verbal structures and expressions: BE; THERE IS/ARE; Modal auxiliary verbs CAN/COULD; HAVE, HAVE GOT (possession); TO HAVE (BREAKFAST, etc.); LOVE, LIKE, HATE; WOULD LIKE; Imperative forms; Multi-word verbs; Infinitive of purpose; Main uses of Gerund and Infinitive
- Subject and Object Pronouns
- Possessive Adjectives and Pronouns, Possessive form of nouns
- Definite and Indefinite articles, Demonstrative Adjectives
- HOW and WH- Questions; WHICH/WHAT; Pronoun WHICH ONE?

- SOME/ANY; HOW MUCH/MANY; A LOT (OF)/MUCH//MANY; A LITTLE
